

Adelaide High School Student Laptop Program

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Adelaide High School is committed to supporting teaching and learning for all students. When students have access to a laptop, they can engage in the school's eLearning environment including Daymap and other web-based technologies.

We are able to offer a laptop program to those students commencing at Adelaide High School in 2026. Students participating in the laptop program will have exclusive possession of an individual laptop, which will connect to the school's networked resources and can be used both at school and at home.

The laptop program includes the following features.

- Access to email and internet
- Access to printing and file storage
- Maintenance of current software
- Access to support from the Adelaide High School ICT Helpdesk.

A three-year onsite hardware warranty is included in the cost along with a three-year accidental damage insurance policy (with \$0 excess per claim - **maximum 3 claims for the life of the policy**).

In 2026, the model we are offering our students is the **HP ProBook 435 x360 G10** at a total cost of \$1,250.00 (Inc GST). The HP ProBook 435 x360 G10 notebook is comprised of:

Participation in the following options associated with the student laptop program is voluntary. If you choose not to participate in options 1 or 2 (see below) your student will continue to have access to desktop workstations at Adelaide High School during school hours only subject to availability.

A 50% deposit and signed commitment to pay OR payment in full needs to be paid via QKR by 20 November 2025 to secure a laptop in 2026. See QKR instructions below. Please contact finance if you have any issues with payment or access to QKR.

There are two options of participation for the Student Laptop Program to choose from:

Option 1 Upfront payment of \$1,250.00 (inc GST) due 20 November 2025

Option 2 50% payment \$625.00 (inc GST) due 20 November 2025
50% payment \$625.00 (inc GST) due 10 April 2026 (invoiced in January 2026)

(This option requires a signed commitment to pay.)

All students will have access to school software (Office 365 and Adobe Creative Cloud apps) while they remain a student at Adelaide High School.

Option 1 or 2 includes an accidental damage insurance policy for the device. The laptop will be covered for three years for repairs for accidental damage including spillage of liquids. The full terms and conditions are available as a download, *Acer Accidental Damage.pdf* from the Adelaide High School website.

The laptop will be available for collection in January 2026. Further information regarding distribution will be advised at a later date.

Option 3

Students who do not choose to participate in the student laptop program, and who are not able to provide their own device, may be able to borrow a laptop from the ICT help desk when needed. These laptops will not be available for take home borrowing, and students will not be able to personalise these in any way. As there are limited numbers of these laptops available for loan, and we cannot guarantee that a laptop will always be available when requested.

You may also provide your student with a device of your own choosing, provided it is:

- A laptop (not an iPad or small tablet)
- Able to sustain battery power for at least 6 hours
- Capable of running applications such as Microsoft Office 365 (*and preferably, the Adobe Creative Cloud Suite, which is made available to all Adelaide High students*).

For students who supply their own device (BYOD), we will provide access to our wireless network and online resources. We are also able to offer limited help desk support. We are not able to supply accidental damage insurance and onsite repairs for devices not supplied by the school.

For approved school card holders

Approved 2026 school card holders will have access to a device that can be taken home and must be returned to Adelaide High School at the end of the school year. Devices can only be issued once school card approval is in place for the 2026 school year.

Adelaide High School is committed to being cyber-safe. Acceptable Use Agreements will apply to all students using the school's ICT resources and infrastructure, both in and out of school hours and must be signed prior to collection of the laptop.
